## PET WASTE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS FOR PARKS

#### Recommendation

The Commissioner of Community Services, in consultation with the Director of Public Works, recommends:

That this report be received for information purposes.

#### Purpose

At the request of Council, staff were directed to report on the cost to install Lipa Dog Toilets in City of Vaughan parks (Committee of the Whole Report No. 11, Item 33, February 12, 2001).

### Background

Lipa Dog Toilets are stand-alone units that are designed to assist pet owners with the proper disposal of animal feces in parks and open space settings. These units have a storage compartment for plastic bags on top, with a container for disposal of the bag, at the bottom (see attachments). The units are set into the ground, with concrete poured into the holes for support.

Staff contacted the supplier of Lipa Dog Toilets and the supplier has indicated that the cost of the unit is \$1,199.95 each, and a case of bags is \$129.00, both prices exclude the federal Goods and Sales Tax. To outfit each existing park and parkette in the City with a single Lipa Dog Toilet, the cost would be approximately \$192,550, excluding the purchase of the bags, and excluding installation costs.

There are a number of related products available, and most of them are significantly less expensive than the Lipa Dog Toilet. Most are containers designed to hold plastic bags, and some of them offer special disposal containers to dispose of the pet feces. The problems with all of these systems, including the Lipa Dog Toilet, are

- potential vandalism to the bag container;
- potential for the plastic bags to be littered around the park;
- the odour from a separate feces container;
- the need to empty the containers on a year round basis; and,
- the ongoing costs to supply bags all year round.

The cost of the Lipa Dog Toilet is a significant concern with respect to vandalism. At over \$1,200 each, replacement of damaged units would be prohibitive. As for the littering of plastic bags, this is a concern that Parks & Forestry staff have with all of these types of units. Vandalism results in increased maintenance costs to clean the parks, increased complaints from residents, and the increased costs to replenish the bags.

Notwithstanding the above, staff are continuing to research and investigate the various types of pet care stations available, and may try to obtain some units on a trial basis for the summer.

### **Conclusion**

The cost to purchase Lipa Dog Toilets for all of the City's parks and parkettes is approximately \$192,550, excluding installation costs.

# COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE - MAY 22, 2001

Staff will continue to look into alternatives, and should Council wish to pursue the installation of Lipa Dog Toilets, or any other brand of pet care station, in its parks, staff will submit a request for funding as part of the 2002 Capital Budget process.
