SPADINA-YORK SUBWAY EXTENSION COMMITTEE BUSINESS CASE

Recommendation

Councillor Racco recommends that the Business Case for the Spadina-York Subway Extension entitled "A Solution for Gridlock in the Northwestern GTA" be presented to Council at its meeting of June 25, 2001.

Purpose

The purpose of this report is to advise Members of Council that the Business Case for the Spadina-York Subway Extension is nearing completion, and will be presented to Vaughan Council at Monday's Council meeting.

Background - Analysis and Options

In March 2001, the City of Vaughan retained the consulting firm of Pricewaterhouse Coopers on behalf of the Spadina-York Subway Extension Committee to prepare Business Case for the proposed subway extension.

The draft Business Case was presented to the Spadina-York Subway Extension Committee on Friday, June 15, 2001. Following input and suggestions from the Committee members, the report will be finalized and available for submission to Council on June 25, 2001. It is the Committee's intention to also formally submit the Business Case to the Councils of the City of Toronto and the Region of York, and to York University.

Conclusion

The final report Business Case "A Solution for Gridlock in the Northwestern GTA" will be presented to Vaughan Council at its meeting of June 25, 2001.
