ALL WAY STOP SIGNS FOR CRANSTON PARK AVE. - MAPLE

Recommendation

Councillor Ferri recommends that all way stop signs be installed at the intersections of Cranston Park Ave and Ashton Dr./Isaac Murray Ave., and Cranston Park Ave. and Ridgeway Ct./Princeton Gate, and

That the request for speed humps along the northern section of Cranston Park Ave., north of Ridgeway Ct./Princeton Gate, be referred to the Maple Springs Traffic Calming Committee – Phase 2, for review and processing as per City policy.

Purpose

The Ward 1 office received a petition from residents of the area.

Background - Analysis and Options

Cranston Park Ave is a 4 lane primary road that is conducive to speeding. The all way stop signs at Cranston Park Ave. and Ashton Drive/Isaac Murray Ave. and Cranston Park Ave. and Ridgeway Ct./Princeton Gate, would help regulate the speed of traffic. Any speed humps for this area need to be referred to Engineering staff and the Phase 2 Traffic Calming Committee as per City policy in order that issues such as costs and engineering may be addressed.

Conclusion

All way stops at the proposed locations will have a positive impact on reducing traffic speed along Cranston Park Ave.
