AGREEMENT WITH THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK

Recommendation

The Director of Recreation and Culture recommends:

That a by-law be enacted to authorize the execution of an agreement between the City of Vaughan and the Regional Municipality of York whereby the Region provides funding for select recreation programmes for eligible children whose parents are in financial need.

Purpose

The purpose is for the Region to fund select recreation programmes for children between the ages of six and twelve years whose parents are in financial need.

Background - Analysis and Options

The Regional Municipality of York is proposing a programme wherein they enter into a Purchase of Service agreement with the City of Vaughan whereby children between the ages of six and twelve years and whose parents are in financial need, will be integrated into City recreation programmes. The rate will be based on the current municipal fee schedule and will be totally funded by the Regional Municipality of York.

There will be no additional cost incurred by the City as a result of this agreement.

Conclusion

This will be the third Purchase of Service agreement between the City and the Regional Municipality of York for the provision of recreation services. As a result of this "partnership", needy children will have an opportunity to benefit from City programmes. Fees will be covered by the Regional Municipality of York and will fulfill their mandate as a Children's Recreation Service Provider pursuant to Ontario Regulation 533/00.
