TURKEY SHOOTS 2002 MAPLE LIONS CLUB

Recommendation

The City Clerk recommends:

- 1. That an exemption to the City of Vaughan Fire Arms By-law 21-86, and Noise By-law 270-81, as amended, be granted to the Maple Lions Club to permit the discharging of fire arms at its monthly turkey shoots scheduled for the year 2002, normally on Sunday, between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., at the Metro Works, Avondale Compost Site; and
- 2. That York Regional Police be so informed.

Purpose

To request an exemption from the City of Vaughan Fire Arms By-law 21-86, and Noise By-law 270-81, as amended, for the Maple Lions Club, so that they may hold their monthly turkey shoots.

Background - Analysis and Options

A request has been received from the Maple Lions Club requesting that an exemption from the City of Vaughan Fire Arms By-law and Noise By-law be granted so that they may hold its monthly turkey shoots throughout 2002 at the Avondale Compost Site. Staff has been advised that permission has been granted by Metro Works allowing the Maple Lions Club to utilize the aforementioned site for these events.

Approval for this request for the full year of 2002 will eliminate this matter being before Council on a monthly basis. The Maple Lions Club will notify the Clerk's Department and York Regional Police once the final dates for the turkey shoots have been scheduled.

This is an annual request from the Maple Lions Club for which Council has granted approval in the past.

Conclusion

Council is requested to grant the request by the Maple Lions Club for an exemption from the City of Vaughan Fire Arms By-law 21-86, and Noise By-law 270-81, so that they may hold their monthly turkey shoots.
