EXTENSION OF SANITARY SEWER SERVICES ON MILL STREET IN THORNHILL

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Development Services and Public Works recommends:

That the Engineering Department extend the preliminary design and cost estimate for the extension of sanitary sewer services on Old Yonge St. in Thornhill to include Mill Street as well.

Purpose

To carry out a preliminary design and prepare a cost estimate for the extension of sanitary sewer services on Mill Street.

Background - Analysis and Options

Item 10, Report No. 77 of the Committee of the Whole, which was adopted by Council on December 18, 2001, authorized staff to proceed with the preparation of a preliminary design and cost estimate for the extension of sanitary sewer services on Old Yonge St. in Thornhill. When survey work commenced on Old Yonge St. before Christmas, interest was expressed by residents of Mill Street for the extension of sanitary sewer services to their homes as well. Five homes front Mill Street – only one of which is directly connected to an abutting sanitary trunk sewer, with the other four homes serviced by on-site sewage (septic) systems. All Mill Street homeowners have contacted the Engineering Department and have expressed a strong desire for the City to install a sanitary sewer as a Local Improvement.

Conclusion

It is recommended that the extension of sanitary sewer services to Old Yonge and Mill Streets be carried forward as one project.
