#### Recommendation

The Sign Variance Committee recommends:

That Sign Variance Application SV.02-06, East Woodbridge Developments, be APPROVED in accordance with the revised plans received May 15, 2002.

#### **Purpose**

Applicant is requesting install two awning signs over the front elevation of their store.

# **Background - Analysis and Options**

### By-Law Requirements (203-92, as amended)

- 6.13(b) No awning sign, or any part thereof, shall project more than 0.5m from the wall upon which it is mounted.
  - (c) No portion of any sign shall be less than 2.44m above the finished floor level immediately below such sign.
- 8.4 (b) The text area on an awning sign shall not exceed 0.5 sq.m. per linear horizontal metre of the exterior wall of a building; upon which such awning is located. In multiple occupancy buildings or shopping centres, the sign area for each business premises shall be proportional to the length of the exterior wall forming part of the premises. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the total text area on an awning sign per business premises shall not exceed 20.0 sq.m. or be limited to less than 2.0 sq.m.

# Conclusion

Applicant is requesting to install two awning signs measuring: (Sign 1) 4.98m x 1.68m, 8.45m<sup>2</sup> of area (Sign 2) 6.07m x 1.68m, 10.18m<sup>2</sup> of area.

The awning projects .76m from the wall. The clearance from floor level to bottom side of awning is unknown. The text area for (Sign 1) is 1.44m<sup>2</sup> and for (Sign 2) is 5.29m<sup>2</sup>.
