AVDELL AVENUE AND BUSH DRIVE BUSH DRIVE AND CARTANYA COURT ALLWAY STOP CONTROL

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works recommends:

- That a by-law be enacted to authorize the existing allway stop at the intersection of Avdell Avenue and Bush Drive; and
- That the existing allway stop be removed at the intersection of Bush Drive and Cartanya Court

Purpose

To re-evaluate the existing allway stop controls at the above noted intersections.

Background - Analysis and Options

It was recently discovered by staff that two allway stop controls have been installed along Bush Drive by developers of the subdivision without accompanying by-laws being brought forward to Council.

The existing allway stop control at the Avdell Avenue and Bush Drive intersection is appropriate since the subdivision is still under development and traffic volumes are expected to soon warrant an allway stop at this location. The existing allway stop control at the Bush Drive and Cartanya Court intersection should be removed. The Provincial allway stop warrant would not be met even once development is complete as there are only 10 residential homes on Cartanya Court.

There are no sight distance restrictions noted at either intersection.

Conclusion

Based on this review, it is recommended that the existing allway stop control remain at the intersection of Avdell Avenue and Bush Drive and that the existing allway stop control be removed at the intersection of Bush Drive and Cartanya Court.
