AWARD OF TENDER - CT- 02-01 (ASPHALT HEATING AND RE-SHAPING)

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works, in consultation with the Director of Purchasing Services, recommends that:

- 1. The Tender CT–02-01 for asphalt heating and re-shaping be awarded to Road Savers 2000 Ltd., at an estimated cost of \$175.00 per hour; and.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk be authorized to sign the necessary documents.

Purpose

To award the tender for asphalt heating and re-shaping, as a result of a tender call by the York Public Buyers Co-operative.

Background - Analysis and Options

The Public Works Department has budgeted \$160,000 for the correction of water ponding, cut repair, and other asphalt deficiencies, using a process whereby the old asphalt is heated, new material added, and the repair area is re-shaped and rolled to grade.

The York Public Buyers Co-operative tenders materials and services that may be required by the Region of York, and the various agencies that participate in the Co-operative. The City of Vaughan is an active participant in this Co-operative.

The following are the results of the Co-operative tender call for asphalt heating and re-shaping:

Road Savers 2000 Ltd. \$175.00 per hour J.A. Robbins Construction \$195.00 per hour Paveseal Ltd. \$205.00 per hour

The Manager of Road Maintenance Services met with the lowest bidder, inspected the quality of work that they have performed in other municipalities, and requested them to perform a sample repair in the City. As a result, he is satisfied that Road Savers 2000 Ltd. can perform the type of work required by the City of Vaughan.

Staff also contacted the references provided (The City of Mississauga and the Town of Richmond Hill), and both references were more than satisfied with the work performed by Road Savers 2000 Ltd.

As such, it is recommended that the tender for asphalt burning and re-shaping be awarded to Road Savers 2000 Ltd.

Conclusion

Based on the tender results, and the inspection of the work performed by Road Savers 2000 Ltd., it is recommended that they be awarded the contract for asphalt heating and re-shaping.
