GLEN SHIELDS AVENUE NEIGHBOURHOOD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLAN

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works recommends:

That this report be received for information purposes.

Purpose

To report on the Glen Shields Avenue Neighbourhood Traffic Management Plan.

Background - Analysis and Options

At its meeting of June 24, 2002, Council directed:

“That the following recommendation contained in the additional report of the Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works, dated June 24, 2002, be approved in principle, subject to a community meeting being held with the Local Councillor and staff, that notice of the meeting be sent to all residents and the Ward 4 Sub-Committee be invited, and that prior to implementation of the plan, that a report be provided to the earliest possible Committee of the Whole meeting:

1. That the Glen Shields Avenue Neighbourhood Traffic Management Plan be approved; and
2. That funds in the amount of \$50,000 for the implementation of the proposed Glen Shields Avenue plan comprising seven asphalt speed humps, one raised crosswalk with impressed concrete top and painted road narrowings on Glen Shields Avenue be drawn from the 2001 Capital Budget (Traffic Calming, Project No. 1203-2).”

A community meeting was held on July 18, 2002, with residents, the Local Councillor and Engineering Department staff. The residents at the meeting voted to defer the Glen Shields Avenue Traffic Management Plan and increase the number of members of the Traffic Committee. A meeting of the Traffic Committee will be held in September 2002. The Committee will then follow the normal Traffic Committee process to develop and present a new Traffic Management Plan to Council.

Conclusion

Following a community meeting in July, a meeting of the Traffic Committee will be held in September to develop a new Traffic Management Plan for the Glen Shields Avenue neighbourhood.


