NAPA VALLEY AVENUE PROPOSED 40 KM/HR SPEED LIMIT

Recommendation

Councillor Linda D. Jackson recommends:

THAT the speed limit on Napa Valley Avenue be reduced to 40km/hr. along the entire length of the street.

Purpose

To maintain a consistent speed throughout the length of Napa Valley Avenue in response to requests received from area residents.

Background

Area residents have expressed concerns regarding the excessive vehicle speeds and the safety of pedestrians on Napa Valley Avenue. The existing speed is a statutory 50km/hr., with the exception of school areas which are a statutory 40km/hr.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that the speed limit on Napa Valley Avenue be reduced from 50km/hr. to 40km/hr. along the entire length of the street.

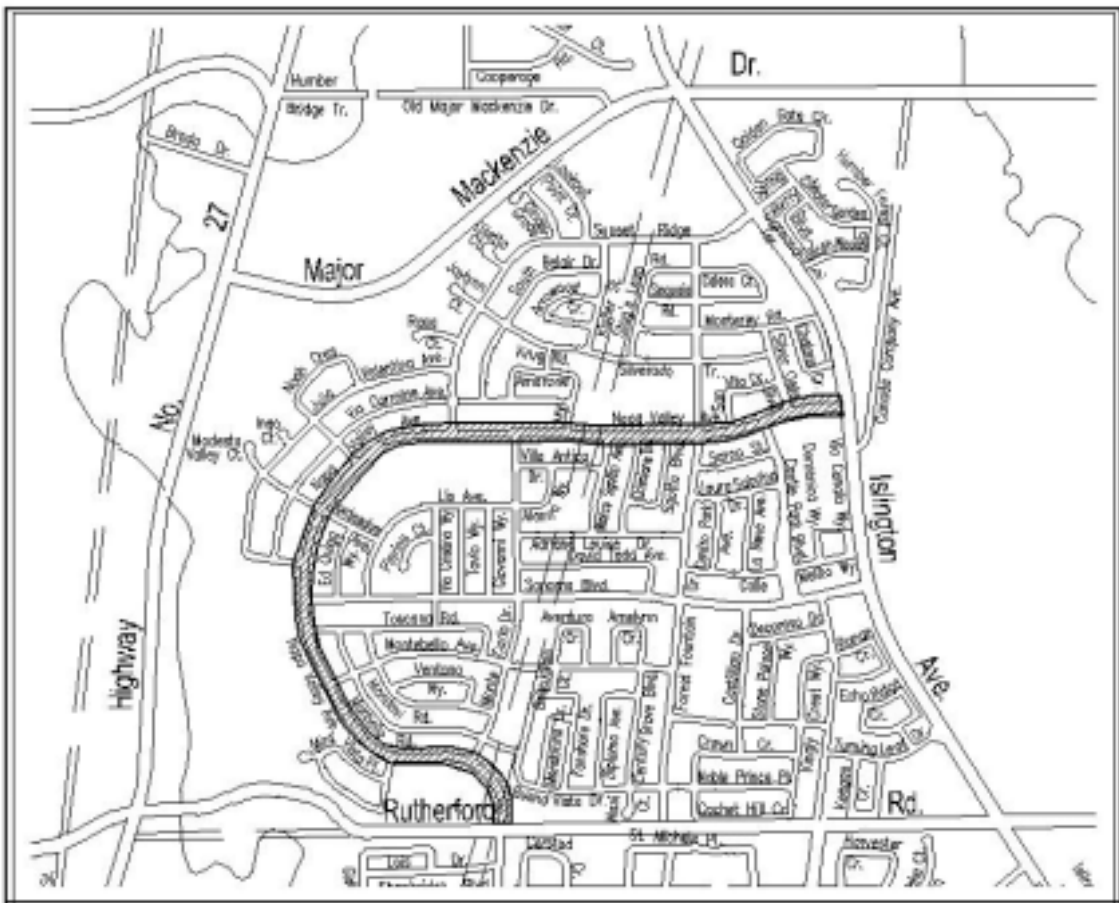
