**NATTRESS STREET/RIVERSIDE DRIVE  
PROPOSED 3 WAY STOP CONTROL**

**Recommendation**

Councillor Linda D. Jackson recommends:

THAT a 3 way stop control be installed at the intersection of Nattress Street and Riverside Drive.

**Purpose**

To review the feasibility of replacing the one way stop control with a 3 way stop control at the intersection of Nattress Street and Riverside Drive in response to requests received from area residents.

**Background**

Area residents have expressed concerns regarding the excessive vehicle speeds on Nattress Street.

Vehicles traveling south on Pine Ridge Avenue navigate the bend onto Nattress at a very high rate of speed. Due to visual restrictions, vehicles must roll into the intersection when making a left turn onto Riverside Drive from Nattress Street in order to determine if the way is clear. These two factors combined create a safety hazard at this intersection.

**Conclusion**

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that a 3 way stop control be installed at the intersection of Nattress Street and Riverside Drive.
