

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE – NOVEMBER 4, 2002

TORII STREET TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENTS

Council adopted the following resolution at the Council meeting of October 28, 2002, with respect to Item 21, Report No. 72 of the Committee of the Whole meeting of October 21, 2002:

“The Committee of the Whole recommends that this matter be referred to the Committee of the Whole meeting of November 4, 2002, to allow staff to review the resident’s petition.”

Recommendation:

Councillor Bernie Di Vona recommends:

That Vaughan Council receives the letter and petition dated October 2002 from the residents of Torii Street;

That the Engineering Dept. reviews the traffic calming measures in the area of Torii Street West of Torii Park;

That a traffic calming agent be implemented, a distance before the section of the road west of Torii Park in order to eliminate speeders in the neighbourhood.

Purpose

To reduce the speeding and the possibility of further accidents occurring.

Background

There have been numerous serious accidents on Torii Street. In fact, five accidents in six years have occurred in the same location.

Vaughan Council has received photos of vehicles that have hit the curb and landed upside down on residential properties, on two separate occasions.

Vaughan Council had approved of a raised crosswalk in the vicinity of the park, with the understanding that the Engineering Dept would revisit this matter.
