CLARENCE STREET PROPOSED 40 KM/HR SPEED LIMIT

Recommendation

Regional Councillor Linda D. Jackson recommends that the following be referred to staff for a report:

To reduce the speed limit on Clarence Street to 40km/hr. between Rutherford Road and Sonoma Boulevard.

Purpose

To maintain a safe speed along this portion of Clarence Street, in response to residents' concerns.

Background

Area residents have expressed concerns regarding the excessive vehicle speeds and the safety of pedestrians on Clarence Street, between Rutherford Road and Sonoma Boulevard. The existing speed is a statutory 50km/hr.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that the speed limit on Clarence Street be reduced from 50km/hr. to 40km/hr., from Rutherford Road to Sonoma Boulevard.
