### **RUSSET WAY AND ANSLEY GROVE TRAFFIC CONTROL**

#### **Recommendation**

Councilor DiVona recommends:

That the petition from the residents of Russet Way with respect to traffic calming measures on Russet Way and Ansley Grove, be received; and

That the City of Vaughan Engineering Department report back within the next quarter with their recommendations including traffic accident history.

#### **Purpose**

To address Russet Way and Ansley Grove traffic control.

#### **Background - Analysis and Options**

Residents on Russet Way in the vicinity of Ansley Grove have expressed their concern with the unsafe and careless driving for several years.

#### **Conclusion**

In response to a request received from area residents, they expressed their concerns with the stretch of Ansley Grove from Chancellor Road to Embassy Road. The residents feel the need to either have several large bumps installed or a four way stop at Russet Way and Ansley Grove to stop the persistent speeding that occurs. Also, another concern they have is the amount of vehicles constantly speeding on Russet Way, they would like several speed bumps installed on Russet ay between Ansley Grove and the park, to minimize the speeding concerns that have become a nuisance over the past several years.
