SERVICING AGREEMENT PROPOSED 300MM WATERMAIN ON ADMINISTRATION ROAD CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAY COMPANY

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works recommends:

That Council enact a by-law authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute a servicing agreement with Canadian National Railway Company (CNR) for the construction of a 300mm diameter municipal watermain on Administration Road from Keele Street to the west limit of the road.

Purpose

The purpose of this report is to seek approval from Council to execute a servicing agreement with CNR to facilitate the construction of a 300mm diameter municipal watermain on Administration Road.

Background

Currently, the existing buildings at 59, 60 and 62 Administration Road are serviced by an existing 200mm diameter watermain owned and operated by CNR. CNR has advised that the properties have been sold to other parties, therefore the provision for municipal water supply to these properties is required.

CNR is prepared to design and construct the watermain at no cost to the City and has to date submitted construction drawings to the Engineering Department for review and approval.

To provide for the design and construction of the watermain, CNR is required to enter into a servicing agreement with the City and the financial guarantee of \$304,085.00 will cover the construction of the proposed watermain works.

Conclusion

Staff recommend that Council enact a by-law authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute a servicing agreement with CNR for the construction of a 300mm diameter municipal watermain on Administration Road.
