

**COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE SEPTEMBER 15TH, 2003**

**PARKING PROHIBITION AND PARK CURFEW**

**Recommendation**

Councillor Kadis recommends:

1. That By-law 1-96 be amended to include a parking prohibition on Pinewood Drive from Payson to the end of the cul de sac from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. 7 days per week;
2. That Vaughan Crest Park be closed at 10 p.m. daily;
3. And that Engineering staff arranges to have the prohibition signs installed.

**Background - Analysis and Options**

As a result of residents concerns regarding increased vandalism and unlawful activity a meeting took place with City of Vaughan By-Law staff, a representative from the York Regional Police a local resident and myself. The purpose of the meeting was to determine ways of enhancing safety and to ensure that residents can enjoy their local park. The police and by-law staff have recommended a parking prohibition and park curfew as deterrents to address unwanted individuals loitering in this area.

**Conclusion**

A parking prohibition and park curfew at 10 p.m. is warranted to reduce problems in the area.
