OUTDOOR EDUCATION CENTRE/VAUGHAN NATURE CAMPS

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Community Services respectfully requests direction on this matter.

Purpose

The purpose of this report is to obtain Council direction on the proposed Outdoor Education Centre in partnership with York Region District School Board.

Background - Analysis and Options

On June 23, 2003 Council deferred the item regarding the proposed Outdoor Education Centre, in order for staff to explore potential partnership opportunities. The item is attached as Appendix A.

The York District Board has approved the project, subject to receiving approval by Vaughan Council. They are anxious to obtain an answer from Vaughan, as to whether this project will be proceeding at this time. From Vaughan's perspective, it would be beneficial to undertake the renovations in the winter of 2004, in order for the building to be ready for use by the Nature Camp programs in the summer.

Staff have not, as yet, had an opportunity to explore additional partnership opportunities, in particular with the private sector. There are many options for partnering on the Maple Nature Reserve lands. Some examples would be trail development, public education programs, arboretum development, etc. These opportunities would not interfere with the proposed Outdoor Education Centre, and in fact the renovated facility could be used on evenings and weekends for community education, meetings and so on.

If Council wishes this project to proceed, the staff recommendations of June 23rd, 2003 should be approved; or alternatively the City could undertake the capital renovations and then permit the space to the Boards of Education.

Conclusion

Council direction is required, the York Region Board has requested a formal response.

- That staff be directed to preced with retaining on Anti-rectural Consultant to prepare plans for the Carperner's Building renovation that will serve as the outdoor education center and the City of Valleghan Nether gamps.

The curpose of this report is to case in approval by the Committee and Council to proceed with pursuing and finalizing a joint use agreement with the York Region District School Board for use of the Maple Nature Reserve and Carperner's Building as an outgood education center.

Background - Analysis and Options

In June of 2000 the City of Vaughan approved the Maple Valley Parks and Open Space Strategy known as the Maple Valley Plan. The plan integrated the Parks and Open Space planning for the entire Keele Valley area including the former MNH funds on the east side of Duffenn Swaal. The former MNR lands were ocquired by the Cay for the purposes of conservation and recreation uses in 1997.

Included in the Maple Valley Plan were specific recommendations for the MNR tands and that the lands 'be referred as a matural erria and designated as a passive park writin the City's park system." The primary activities universeled were those related to:

- Ecological Restoration and Educational Benefits
- Recreation Programming
- Divid Administration
- Land Sweareship and Resource Management
- Community Uses and Passive Park,
- Trail Development.

Community constitution was undertaken in the form of statisholder mastings. The especiallying involved references representatives, an archmental groups, conservation groups and other intercelled persons. Four mastings were held on May 22°°, July 9° and September 24° in 2407 and May 12, 2008. In addition agencies were consisted, Including the TRCA and Com Council, York Region District School Board and the York Region September School Board.

Of note was the interest the York Region District School Board showed for partnering with the City to white the site for outdoor aducation.

Several meetings have been held with the York Region Detrict School Scard to review their interest in unliking the Maple Nature Regions and the Corporater's Building as an auditor aducation center it is the Board's intent to utilize the outdoor education center from September 1 to June 30 for a ten year pened commenting in October of this year. The Board estimates that a meanism of 40 children would attend the site at one time. The City will comprise to utilize the Maple Nature Reserve for the summer day comps and recreation programs from July 1 to August 31 and during both the City tenses and March breaks.

The York Region Detrict School Board's intended use of the entire two floors of the Carpenter's Building will require that the sinuclare be renovabled so that it meets current building code standards. A study undertaken by Buildings and Festives identifies that the required renovations must include the addition of one washroom structural support for the second floor improvements to the exit staticate from the second floor, and insultation of drywall throughout the entire first floor based on the York Region District School Board's intended use of the building.

In order to complete the required removations on Architectural Consultant must be retained to prepare drawings and specifications for the renovation of the Corporate's Building. The York Region Destrict School Board will contribute 212ths of the consulting fee crists are the City of Veughan will contribute 312ths of the loter capital renovation costs, which are estimated to be approximately \$15,000.00 (City of Veughan share is approximately \$3,780,00), 2003 capital hands are available to secure this consultant.

Capital expenditures for the renovation to the Carpentar's Building will be cost shared by the York Region District School Board and the City of Vaughan. The York Region District School Board will contribute 9/12/the of the total capital renovation costs and the City of Vaughan will contribute 3/12/the of the total capital renovation costs, which are estimated to be approximately \$180,000 (0) of Vaughan share is approximately \$45,000 (0). A funding source has yet to be identified to pay for the City of Vaughan's share of the renovation costs. The York Region District School Board is currently finalizing approvals of their share of the required capital funds for the renovation of the Carpentar's Ruiging.

Conclusion
