# CHELTENHAM AVENUE NO STOPPING

#### **Recommendation**

Councillor Linda D. Jackson recommends:

THAT "No Standing" signs be installed on the north side of Cheltenham Avenue, from Kipling Avenue easterly to the first residential driveway.

#### **Purpose**

To discourage motorists from driving onto the shoulder and grassy areas, causing damage to private and City property.

## **Background**

Cheltenham Avenue is being used as a parking area for patrons of the businesses on Kipling Avenue. Cheltenham Avenue is a fairly narrow street, which forces motorists to park on grassy areas to accommodate continued traffic flow. The shoulders and grassy areas are being destroyed, particularly when the ground is very soft following a rainfall or thaw.

Area residents have expressed concerns regarding the destruction of vegetation and have requested that vehicles not be allowed to park in this area.

## Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that "No Standing" signs be installed on the north side of Cheltenham Avenue, from Kipling Avenue easterly to the first residential driveway.
