**SUNSET RIDGE
PROPOSED 40 KM/HR SPEED LIMIT**

Recommendation

Councillor Linda D. Jackson recommends:

THAT the speed limit on Sunset Ridge be reduced to 40km/hr. from Napa Valley Avenue to Islington Avenue.

Purpose

To maintain a safe speed throughout the area of the new WEA district park, in response to residents' concerns.

Background

Area residents have expressed concerns regarding the excessive vehicle speeds and the safety of pedestrians on Sunset Ridge, between Napa Valley Avenue and Islington Avenue. The existing speed is a statutory 50km/hr.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents and to maintain safe speeds in the area of a district park, it is recommended that the speed limit on Sunset Ridge be reduced from 50km/hr. to 40km/hr. from Napa Valley Avenue to Islington Avenue.
