SUNSET RIDGE & JULIA VALENTINA AVENUE <u>3-WAY STOP CONTROL</u>

Recommendation

In response to requests from area residents, Councillor Linda D. Jackson recommends:

THAT a three-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Sunset Ridge and Julia Valentina Avenue.

<u>Purpose</u>

To reduce and control speeds along Sunset Ridge and encourage motorists exiting Julia Valentina Avenue to exercise caution when proceeding onto Sunset Ridge.

Background

Sunset Ridge is a busy street with motorists using it as an access road into the Sonoma Heights subdivision and as a shortcut from Islington Avenue through to Rutherford Road. It is expected to become busier, with increased vehicular and pedestrian traffic, once the WEA district park is completed.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that a three-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Sunset Ridge and Julia Valentina Avenue.
