Whereas a police presences would encourage community safety and well being; and

Whereas police presence would encourage community communications with police officers; and

Whereas police officers would have a location to attend and provide for police needs.

This report is consistent with the priorities previously set by Council and the necessary resources have not been allocated and approved.

It is my feeling that providing satellite offices to the York Regional Police could provide the residents of the City of Vaughan with a safer community.
