ASSUMPTION - OCHRE BARON <u>19T-97V34 / 65M-3334</u>

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Engineering and Public works recommends:

That the necessary by-law be passed assuming the municipal services in the Subdivision Agreement for Plan 65M-3334, and that the municipal services letter of credit be reduced to \$30,000 as per Park's request for street trees guarantee.

<u>Purpose</u>

The subdivision has been completed and is ready to be assumed by the City.

Background - Analysis and Options

The 95 lot development is a residential subdivision. The development is located south of Rutherford Road, west of Dufferin Street, as shown on Attachment 1.

The Subdivision Agreement was signed on June 9, 1999.

The municipal services in Plan 65M-3334 were installed in May 1999, and the top course asphalt was placed in August 2001.

All the documentation required by the Subdivision Agreement for assumption has been submitted. The Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works has received inspection clearance from all pertinent City Departments and the City Treasurer has confirmed that all of the City's financial requirements regarding this subdivision have been met. Parks Department has requested that the letter of credit be reduced to \$30,000 in order to provide for the guaranteed maintenance period and to secure any further tree replacements that may be required. Trees replaced during the maintenance period will be inspected at the end of their guarantee period.

Relationship to Vaughan Vision 2007

The development of this subdivision and the assumption of the municipal services is consistent with Vaughan Vision 2007, which encourages managed growth through the implementation of OPA 600 (4.7.1). OPA policies require that development take place in accordance with the requirements and standards of the City and relevant agencies.

This report is consistent with the priorities previously set by Council and the necessary resources have been allocated and approved.

Conclusion

It is now appropriate that the municipal services in 65M-3334 be assumed and the municipal services letter of credit be reduced to \$30,000 for possible tree replacements. The letter of credit will be reduced and released as the trees are reinspected and certified.
