DUFFERIN HILL DRIVE – NO PARKING SIGN

Recommendation

Councillor Sandra Yeung Racco recommends:

1. That staff be requested to investigate the need for and the feasibility of installing “No Parking” controls between the hours of 7:30 am and 9:30 am and the hours of 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm on both the north and south sides of Dufferin Hill Drive from Dufferin Street to Marathon Drive; and
2. That staff report to a future Committee of the Whole meeting with respect to their findings as soon as possible.

Purpose

To control parking issues on Dufferin Hill Drive.

Background - Analysis and Options

Between the hours of 7:30 am to 9:30 am and 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm, cars are often double and triple parked on both the north and south sides of Dufferin Hill Drive between Dufferin Street and Marathon Drive as children are being dropped off and picked up from the private school at the southwest corner of Dufferin Street and Dufferin Hill Drive. As a result, this parking situation leads to dangers to both pedestrians, as well as vehicular traffic turning in from Dufferin Street. A “No Parking” control will eliminate the dangers derived from this parking situation during the times in question.

Conclusion

In order to maintain community safety, it is recommended that staff review the need for the above-mentioned “No Parking” control during the subject times.
