RECONSIDERATION PROCLAMATION REQUEST – WHITE RIBBON AGAINST PORNOGRAPHY WEEK IN VAUGHAN

Recommendation

The City Clerk recommends:

- 1) That the request to proclaim October 18-25, 2004 as "White Ribbon Against Pornography Week in Vaughan" be reconsidered;
- 2) That October 17-24, 2004 be proclaimed as "White Ribbon Against Pornography Week in Vaughan;
- 3) That the proclamation be posted on the City's website, published on the City Page, space permitting, and that staff issue a news release; and
- 4) That Council declares that the City of Vaughan denounces the destructive influences of obscenity, pornography and indecency pertaining to children on the Internet.

Purpose

To respond to the request received from the President of the Catholic Women's League (CWL) of the parish of St. Padre Pio (Kleinburg).

Background - Analysis and Options

At the Council meeting of June 28, 2004, Council approved the proclamation request with respect to this matter (Refer to Attachment 1) and further adopted the following:

By declaring that the City of Vaughan denounces the destructive influences of obscenity, pornography and indecency pertaining to children on the Internet.

We have just been advised by Ms. Terri Tino, President of CWL, St. Padre Pio Parish that the dates provided to us in June were incorrect and she has requested that the matter be rectified.

Relationship to Vaughan Vision 2007

This report is consistent with the priorities previously set by Council and the necessary resources have been allocated and approved.

Conclusion

In order to correct this matter, Council will need to reconsider the resolution adopted at the June 28, 2004 Council meeting and approve the recommendation in this report.

Publishing proclamations on the City Page depends on space availability. Corporate Communications will, given sufficient lead-time, issue news releases in support of the proclamation.

Dear Mr. Leach,

Last year, Mayor Di Biase and City Council proclaimed the week of October 19th-26th as White Ribbon Against Pornography Week in Vaughan. It was a huge success because we had incredible support from the community and York Regional Police. We are very grateful to Mayor Di Biase and City Council for setting a precedent.

The Catholic Women's League of St Padre Pio, St Margaret Mary and Immaculate Conception are requesting again, that the week of October 18th-25th 2004 be proclaimed as White Ribbon Against Pornography Week in Vaughan. As we are not a charitable organization but rather a non-profit organization, we can only provide the City of Vaughan with our GST exemption number. This is 108076068. We pray this will be enough to ensure the success of WRAP week again. There has never been a problem in other jurisdictions having this week proclaimed and we trust that there will be no obstacles in our community's need to protect our children.

Currently, the age of consent for sexual activity in Canada is 14. This law gives legal permission for adults to exploit and abuse children as young as 14 if they claim that the child said "yes". Briefly, it is our intention to make the community of Vaughan aware of the destructive influences of obscenity, pomography and indecency especially as it pertains to our children and their safety on the internet. More and more we are faced with children being exploited, abused, abducted and murdered for the sexual gratification of adults. We must protect our children, our greatest resource.
