REMOVAL OF STOP SIGNS IN WARD 3

Recommendation

Councillor Bernie DiVona recommends:

- 1. That the existing all-way stop signs located on the following intersections installed by the developer be approved. Via Campanile / La Rocca; Vellore Avenue / St. Urbain Drive; and Vellore Avenue / Maria Antonia.
- 2. That the necessary By-law be enacted.

The traffic control measures will result in slower traffic along these intersections, reducing emission of green house gases, which increase at higher rates of travel.

Purpose

Residents have been calling requesting the all-way stop signs not be removed and feel are required to ensure safety in the area.

Background - Analysis and Options

All-way stop signs were placed on the above streets in error through the development process and do not meet the provincial warrant for an all-way stop. Arrangements are currently being made for the stop signs to be removed.

Residents feel that there is a safety concern and want to keep them in place.
