**Whereas**, in deference to the concerns of the Clerk regarding the security of internet voting, the Task Force on Democratic Participation and Renewal deferred inclusion of a recommendation that internet voting be allowed in the 2010 municipal election; and

**Whereas**, the general perception is that internet voting will result in a greater turnout of voters; and

**Whereas**, other jurisdictions are moving to internet voting, in the belief that security is now less of an issue or not an issue; and

**Whereas**, the Clerk has undertaken to review the question of internet voting in the 2014 election;

***Now therefore be it resolved***

That the members of the Task Force be invited to meet with the Clerk from time to time, to address the means and appropriateness of introducing internet voting in the 2014 election, provided that the Clerk and a majority of the Task Force believe that a secure method of internet voting has been identified and the integrity of the voting process will be preserved.
