ROE ROAD, ROAD CLOSURE

Recommendation

- 1) That any deputations on the matter be received; and
- 2) That a By-law be enacted to stop-up, close and convey a portion of Roe Road at its intersection with Nashville Road

<u>Purpose</u>

To enact a by-law to stop-up, close and convey a portion of Roe Road where it intersects with Nashville Road.

Background – Analysis and Options

Council, at its meeting of June 11, 2001, resolved that the necessary steps be taken to stop-up, close and convey a portion of Roe Road at its intersection with Nashville Road. The notice for the proposed road closure was subsequently advertised for four (4) consecutive weeks in the Liberal as required in the Municipal Act. A copy of the notice is attached.

The appropriate agencies have been notified of the proposed by-law. No objections were received.

Conclusion

In order to complete the road closure process, Council's approval of this recommendation is required.


