COUNCIL SUPPORTED FUNDRAISING EVENTS

The Committee of the Whole (Working Session) recommends approval of the recommendation contained in the following report of the Director of Corporate Communications, dated October 30, 2001:

Recommendation

The Director of Corporate Communications, in consultation with the Director of Recreation and Culture, recommends that the following policy be adopted:

- 1) That the City of Vaughan continue to support the United Way, through staff resources and that continued staff involvement and commitment be encouraged;
- 2) That the City of Vaughan support a major charity, to be determined annually by Council, through the Mayor's Annual Golf Tournament;
- 3) That notwithstanding existing policies on support of Community Service and Social Service Organizations and with the exception of the United Way, the City not allocate resources for fundraising efforts of non-profit or charitable organizations on the principle that charitable donations are a personal choice best made by the individual; and
- 4) That the four organizations, previously supported by Council due to their being deemed beneficial to the community as a whole, be grand-fathered under this policy, and that the nature of such support be the purchase of a City of Vaughan table at the fundraising event, with the cost being allocated to the Council Corporate Budget. The four events are identified as being The Woodchoppers Ball, The Humber Regional Hospital Gala, The York Central Hospital Gala, and the York Region Police Chief's Dinner.

ACCESSORY BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES/RESIDENTIAL ZONES CITY OF VAUGHAN <u>FILE: Z.01.005 (15.77)</u>

The Committee of the Whole (Working Session) recommends:

- 1) That the recommendation contained in the following report of the Commissioner of Planning, dated October 30, 2001, be received; and
- 2) That staff be requested to provide a further report to a future Committee of the Whole (Working Session) meeting addressing the concerns expressed with respect to garden/storage sheds, including the provision of proportionate shed size to lot size requirements, restrictions for exterior yard setbacks, landscaped privacy screening, aesthetic appearance and building materials, and investigate the possibility of including these restrictions in the Block Plan process.

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Planning recommends:

- 1. THAT Council approve a revision to the By-law 1-88 zone standards for Accessory Buildings and Structures to increase the maximum size of garden sheds and cabanas from 6m² to 10m²; and,
- 2. THAT Staff be directed to forward a by-law amendment implementing the revised standard to a future meeting of Council for enactment.

AMENDMENT TO ZONING BY-LAW 1-88 CITY OF VAUGHAN SATELLITE DISHES FILE: 15.79

The Committee of the Whole (Working Session) recommends:

- 1) That the recommendation contained in the following report of the Commissioner of Planning, dated October 30, 2001, be approved; and
- 2) That staff be directed to meet with Industry Canada to address the concerns raised with respect to determining restrictions on satellite dishes greater than .9m square or in diameter, as well as imposing height restrictions on towers and antennas, and addressing minimum setback requirements.

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Planning recommends:

- 1. THAT Staff be directed to prepare the necessary amendments to the Zoning By-law to implement the following standards respecting satellite dishes/antennae:
 - a) that dishes less than .9m square or in diameter be attached to the main building, and be no higher than the height of the building; and
