#### 2004 OPERATING BUDGET

The Budget Committee recommends approval of the recommendation contained in the following report of the City Manager and the Commissioner of Finance and Corporate Services, dated September 18, 2003:

#### **Recommendation**

The City Manager and the Commissioner of Finance & Corporate Services in consultation with the Senior Management Team and the Director of Budgeting and Financial Planning, recommends:

That the following report on the 2004 Operating Budget be received for information purposes, and;

That following the Mayor's Summit the 2004 Operating Budget process include the following:

That staff undertake a core services review;

That the process of aligning services with resources be undertaken;

That the Operating Budget process include recommendations to avoid reliance on reserve/surplus "one-time" funding;

That a report be provided to a future Budget Committee with options for consideration in the 2004 Operating Budget process; and

That the external strategic planning consultants be engaged to undertake the core services review.

### 2 STAFFING CHANGES – FULL TIME ROADS SUPERVISOR POSITION

The Budget Committee recommends approval of the recommendation contained in the following report of the Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works, dated September 18, 2003:

#### **Recommendation**

The Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works recommends that the two, vacant, temporary Roads Supervisor complement positions be deleted, and replaced with a full-time Roads Supervisor position.

#### 3 EAST VAUGHAN SALT STORAGE STRUCTURE – REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDS

The Budget Committee recommends:

- 1) That the recommendation contained in the following report of the Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works, dated September 18, 2003, be approved;
- 2) That staff be directed to proceed with the purchase of additional lands; and
- 3) That staff be directed to proceed to negotiate with the Ontario Realty Corporation a long-term lease for lands for parking.

#### **Recommendation**

The Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works, in consultation with the Director of Reserves and Investments, recommends that:

- 1. An additional \$250,000 be approved to cover the costs of site preparation for the east Vaughan salt structure;
- 2. A contingency in the amount of \$25,000 also be approved to cover any potential additional site preparation or construction costs not yet identified;
- That the inclusion of the matter on a Public Council Agenda for the additional funding request as "East Vaughan Salt Storage Structure – Request For Additional Funds" is deemed sufficient notice pursuant to Section 2 (1) (c) of By-law 394-2002; and
- 4. That the source of funding be from City Wide Development Charges Public Works (\$247,500) and Taxation (\$27,500).
