2003 DRAFT CAPTIAL BUDGET

The Special Committee of the Whole (Budget) recommends:

- 1) That Clauses 3 and 4 contained in the following report of the Commissioner of Finance and Corporate Services, dated January 13, 2003, be approved;
- 2) That the following capital projects identified between the Approved December 16, 2002 funding line and the Revised January 13, 2003 funding line (Attachment 1), be approved, subject to the Fire Chief confirming that co-funding from the Fire-fighters Benevolent Fund for Project 3165, "Community Safety Village" in the amount of \$25,000, is available and deleting Project 3163 "Fire Inspector Vehicles (2):

3) That Project 1444-2, "Rural Road Upgrading-Various", be reduced from \$2,000,000 to \$1,500,000 and Project 1483, "2004 Pre Eng / Design – Road Reconstruction Program" be

approved with the understanding that the \$500,000 will be replaced in Project 1444-2 for 2004;

- 4) That the 2003 Proposed Capital Funding Taxation (Attachment 2) be approved subject to the following:
 - a) That the \$841,000 unallocated taxation funds be apportioned as follows:
 - +/-\$200,000 be allocated to the 10% taxation co-funding for Maple Community Centre and Garnet Williams Community Centre expansion;
 - +/-\$300,000 be allocated to the Civic Centre renovations; and
 - the remainder, in the amount of \$341,000, be allocated to Project 1099, "Enterprise GIS";
 - b) That Staff provide a report identifying alternative funding sources for the balance of the funds required for Project 1099, "Enterprise GIS";
 - c) That Project 7932 "Patricia Kemp Centre Add Parking Lot Lights" be approved and staff provide a report identifying the critical health and safety related projects not approved in 2003; and
- 5) That staff report back on opportunities to maximize the proceeds from the sale of the Pine Valley lands for the highest and best use, and further report on the developable acres and access onto Pine Valley Drive, understanding that part of the proceeds will go towards relocation of soccer fields and recreational facilities.

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Finance and Corporate Services in consultation with The Acting City Manager, the Senior Management Team and the Director of Reserves & Investments recommend:

- 1) That those capital projects identified between the Approved December 16, 2002 funding line and the Revised January 13, 2003 funding line be approved; and,
- 2) That the 2003 Capital Proposed funded from Taxation (Attachment 2) be approved; and
- 3) That Council is advised that an additional report will be provided addressing a request for additional funding for the expansion of the Maple Community Centre and the Garnet Williams Community Centre and for renovations to address space needs; and,
- 4) That the 2003 Draft Capital Budget be presented for discussion at the Public Meeting scheduled for January 27, 2003.
