The following items were dealt with:

#### 1 THORNHILL VILLAGE FESTIVAL GRANT

The Committee of the Whole recommends that this matter be referred to the Council meeting of August 25, 2003, for a report addressing grants given to the Thornhill Village Festival and other community events in previous years and the types of services-in-kind provided to the Thornhill Village Festival.

#### Recommendation

Councillor Kadis recommends that a \$5,000 grant be given to the Thornhill Village Festival Committee.

#### 2 OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMITS

The Committee of the Whole recommends:

- 5. Temporarily prohibit parking on both sides of the following road section between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 6, 2003;
  - a) Islington Avenue from Stegman's Mill Road to Pennon Road.
