

COUNCIL MEETING - DECEMBER 12, 2005

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AWARD OF TENDER T05-279 VAUGHAN CIVIC CENTRE STORM SEWER RELOCATION

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Community Services in consultation with the Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works, the Director of Reserves and Investments and the Director of Purchasing Services recommends:

- 1) That Tender T05-279 for the Vaughan Civic Centre Storm Sewer Relocation be awarded to Kapp Contracting Inc. for \$202,454.70 (G.S.T. included).
- 2) That a contingency allowance in the amount of \$37,000.00 (G.S.T. included) be approved within which the Commissioner of Community Services or his designate is authorized to approve amendments to the contract;
- 3) That a Geotechnical Inspection and Material Testing amount of \$16,050.00 (G.S.T. included) be approved to ensure compliance with all applicable standards; and
- 4) That the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to sign the appropriate documents.

Economic Impact

The total cost of \$262,455.00 for the project is included in the 2005 approved capital budget and as such there is no additional economic impact to the 2005 Capital Budget.

Long-range financial implications will include operating and maintenance costs associated with this type of infrastructure and will be included in the revised long-range replacement schedule.

<u>Purpose</u>

Council approval to award Tender No. T05-279 for the Vaughan Civic Centre Storm Sewer Relocation.

Background - Analysis and Options

This tender (2004 Capital Budget Project 37-2-04) includes the Vaughan Civic Centre Storm Sewer Relocation. (See attached map). This work is required to allow for the future construction of the new Civic Centre.

The tender was advertised in the Daily Commercial News, the Electronic Tendering Network (ETN) and on the Ontario Public Buyers Association (OPBA), and closed on Thursday, December 1, 2005. A total of nineteen (19) documents were picked up from the Purchasing Department and the following 13 compliant bids were received:

The estimated cost for this project including provisional items, inspection and testing, a contingency allowance and all applicable taxes (G.S.T. is 100% recoverable) is \$262,455.00 and is calculated as follows:

Staff and the City's consultant for this project KPMB Architects have reviewed the submitted bids and are satisfied that the low bidder Kapp Contracting Inc. is deemed qualified to successfully complete this project. Therefore, it is appropriate to award this contract to Kapp Contracting Inc.

Relationship to Vaughan Vision 2007

This project is consistent with Vaughan Vision 2007 in that the proposed works ensure that municipal operations are undertaken in an environmentally responsible manner (4.4.4.)

This report is consistent with the priorities previously set by Council.

Conclusion

Sufficient funding is available in the 2004 Capital Budget (Project 37-2-04) to complete the project. Staff recommend that this contract be awarded to Kapp Contracting Inc. in the amount of \$202,454.70 (G.S.T. included)
