The Safe City Committee is requesting that Council receive this report for information, place the report on the City's website, and forward the report to York Region School Boards with a request that it be distributed to the School Councils.

Background - Analysis and Options

At the Safe City Committee meeting of June 22, 2009, the committee approved the final Safe City survey and recommended that the survey be forwarded to Council for information, made available on the City website, and forwarded to the school boards for distribution to the School Councils.

The Safe City Committee undertakes to conduct a questionnaire-type survey every 3 years to allow an opportunity for residents to express their personal opinions on the subject of safety and security. Feedback was also sought with respect to existing safety programs to determine whether or not the public is satisfied with the committee's efforts. The 2008 Safe City Survey was administered using local publications and newspapers, and was available on the City's website. Printed copies were

distributed and available at all City community centres and libraries, and at the Civic Centre. The 2008 survey received 2, 141 responses.

The survey represents an accumulation of public opinion with respect to attitudes of the public towards 'acts of crime' compared against actual crime rates as provided by York Regional Police. The public opinion and attitudes may be consistent or inconsistent with the actual criminal activity within the City of Vaughan for various reasons. Depending on the objective of what is being measured and evaluation criteria, public opinion may either mirror or diverge from actual crime rates.

Surveys are useful because they are a form of two-way communication. The Safe City survey this year was focused on community Vandalism. It gave valuable feedback as to citizens' perceptions about this crime, and their level of involvement in preventing and or reporting acts of vandalism. This provided the committee with valuable information regarding awareness levels in the community and the education required to enhance community safety and residents' perception of their safety and security.
