Purpose

To respond to the request received from the Branch President of the Region of York Branch of the Canadian Red Cross.

The correspondence received from the Branch President of the Region of York Branch of the Canadian Red Cross is attached. (Attachment #1).

A request has been received from the Region of York Branch of the Canadian Red Cross, with respect to proclaiming the month of March as "Red Cross Month" in the City of Vaughan. They also request that the City of Vaughan make this proclamation in conjunction with a flag raising ceremony.

The Region of York Branch of the Canadian Red Cross Society this year will celebrate 100 years as a National Organization. Every year in March, the Canadian Red Cross runs a public awareness campaign to increase public awareness and gain support for their many important programs and services, including its Disaster Relief and Community Services.




