Whereas the City of Vaughan has a highly skilled and experienced municipal staff.

- The City of Vaughan communicate with Chief Spence and her advisors in order to determine the forms of assistance that could be provided immediately by Vaughan to alleviate the current crisis, and
- 2. \$10,000 be allotted by the City of Vaughan to provide such support as required, and

 discussions be initiated between the City of Vaughan and the Attawpiskat community on developing a plan to establish a long-term program of cooperation and development between the two municipalities.
