Recommendation

The Director of Legal Services recommends that an exemption to the Noise By-law be granted for a six week period commencing May 20, 2001 for York Region Contract No. 01-150 – Resurfacing of Highway 7, from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. weeknights, except Fridays and Saturdays.

Background

We have received a request from York Region Transportation and Works Department (attached) requesting an exemption to the City's Noise By-law to facilitate planing and resurfacing work on Highway 7 from Weston Road to Pine Valley Drive and from Highway 427 to Highway 50 commencing the long weekend in May and extending for approximately five weeks. They have indicated that due to high traffic volumes on Highway 7, the most practical time to carry out these works is from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. throughout the week, except for Friday and Saturday nights.


