CHURCH STREET – MAPLE PROPOSED PARKING RESTRICTION

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Development Services recommends:

That a parking prohibition be implemented on the north side of Church Street from Keele Street to Jackson Street, Monday to Friday, 8:00 am to 9:00 am and 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm, September 1 to June 30.

Purpose

Staff reviewed the feasibility of implementing a parking prohibition on Church Street and on Jackson St, in response to a request from an area resident. The resident expressed concerns relating to the parked vehicles on both of these streets and how it restricts traffic flow.

Background - Analysis and Options

Staff conducted a parking review and observations on both streets during the time periods of 8:00 am to 9:00 am and 3:30 pm to 5:00 pm on April 11, 2001. The results of the study are indicated below.

- Church Street has 'One-way' travel in the eastbound direction between Jackson Street and Keele Street.
- There is a day-care facility located on the south side of Church Street at Keele Street.
- During the study periods, vehicles were parked on both sides of Church Street for parent
 pick up/drop off activity. With the narrow pavement width, the available travel portion on
 Church Street is reduced with vehicles parking on both sides of the roadway. It was
 observed that a school bus had difficulties travelling eastward on Church Street and at
 one point had to wait for several vehicles to move before continuing.
- There is an office building located on the west side of Jackson Street at Major Mackenzie Drive.
- During the study periods, the parking activity on Jackson Street was minimal. At one
 time, two vehicles were parked at 9:10 am and five vehicles were parked at 4:10 pm on
 the west side of the roadway. There were no vehicles parked on the east side of the
 roadway in pm period and only two vehicles in the am period, which did not impede
 traffic flow.

Conclusion

Based on the above study results, it is recommended that a parking prohibition be implemented on the north side of Church Street, Monday to Friday, 8:00 am to 9:00 am and 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm, September 1 to June 30. Also, it is recommended that no further parking prohibitions be implemented on Jackson Street.


