Purpose

The Owner has submitted street name(s) for approval by the City to satisfy a condition of draft approval.

Background - Analysis and Options

The City of Vaughan approved street names for part of Block 10 on October 10, 2000. In the report, the proposed street name for Street 'BY' was misspelled and Street 'BY' was not shown on the attachment. This report is required to confirm the name of Street "BY" on the attached map as "Burgundy Trail".

The City is closing the north-south portion of Maple Sugar Lane. The east-west portion of Langstaff Road is known as Maple Sugar Lane, but has not been officially named 'Maple Sugar Lane' and as such, a street name change process is required.

Conclusion

Staff considers the proposed street name to be satisfactory and should Council concur, the proposed name should be approved.
