AWARD OF TENDER, T01-204 FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF ONE MECHANICAL STREET SWEEPER

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Community Services, in consultation with the Executive Director of Building, Facilities & Parks, the Director of Purchasing, and the Director of Reserves & Investments, recommends:

1. That Tender T01-204, for the supply and delivery of one current year model pickup type, 6 wheel (4x2) single engine mechanical street sweeper be awarded to Joe Johnson Equipment for a total cost of \$229,973.55
2. That additional funds of \$29,973.55 be approved from the Vehicle Equipment Reserve Fund .

Purpose

To award Tender T01-204, for the supply and delivery of one current year model pickup type, six wheel (4x2) single engine mechanical street sweeper. Project 4957-0-01

Background – Analysis and Options

Project 4957-0-01 was approved for \$200,000 in 2001 as part of the Capital Budget. Council approved funds to purchase a street sweeper as part of the ongoing equipment replacement program. This project is funded from the Vehicle Reserve Fund.

Tender T01-204 was issued for the supply and delivery of a mechanical street sweeper. This equipment has reached life expectancy and has generated high maintenance costs.

This tender T01-204 tender was advertised in the Liberal and the Electronic Tendering Network (ETN), with seven (7) bid documents issued and two (2) received on closing date, October 31st 2001. The result of the bids including GST and PST are as follows:

2)	Tennant Regional Office	\$289,542.40

Conclusion

Based on the tender results, and the ability of the manufacturer to supply the required equipment, it is recommended that the tender be awarded to Joe Johnson Equipment Inc.
