VAUGHAN GROVE SPORTS PARK - CHANGE IN LICENSE FOR HISTORIC HOUSE

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Community Services in consultation with the Director of Legal Services recommends:

That the City of Vaughan support the change in use of the former Tushingham House to a Centre For Children With Autism; and

That a License between the City of Vaughan and the Shining Through Centre for Children With Autism is hereby approved in accordance with the land lease between the City and the Ontario realty Corporation; and that a bylaw be enacted and authorize its execution.

That the License between the City of Vaughan and the Canadian Seniors Development Corp. be terminated.

<u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of this report is to advise Council that the Shining Through Centre For Autism wishes to proceed with the License as soon as possible in order to facilitate their use of the house.

Background - Analysis and Options

Council on January 28th received the attached report regarding a proposal by the Shining Through Centre for Children With Autism to use the former Tushingham house as their Centre. A further report was requested. This was in response to issues regarding the suitability of the house as a Centre For Children with Autism, and the associated renovation costs. The proponents for the Centre have reached an agreement with Rossbro Developments, the owners of the building, and are now ready to proceed with the necessary renovations. Both parties are satisfied with the arrangement.

In order for this project to proceed, it is necessary for the City to enter into a license agreement with Shining Through for the use of the lands; and to terminate the existing agreement with the Canadian Seniors Development Corp.

Conclusion

Staff support the change in use of the former Tushingham House, as the Centre for Children With Autism will serve an identified need in the community.

The Shiring Triongh Centre have been negatisting with Mr. Rossetto with a waw to purchase the binisal however, that would require the City terminaling the agreement with Canadian Seriors. Development Corporation and entering into a new agreement with Shiring Through.

Staff has recently mail with the Shining Through representatives as well as Mr. Rossettic, however there has been incufficient time to review all aspects of this proposal such as zoning, building permit requirements. ORC approval, and other considerations. A report will be brought to Council.

Conclusion

Although the proposed use of the Tushingham house by Shiring Through Centre for Children With Autosm does not the with the original intert for a seniors centre, it is a non-profil chartable community service agency that would serve a community need and is appropriate in that setting.
