AWARD OF TENDER T02-083 INTERSECTION SIGNALIZATION – VARIOUS LOCATIONS (2002)

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works, in consultation with the Director of Purchasing, recommends:

- 1. That Tender T02-083 for Intersection Signalization Various Locations (2002) in the amount of \$503,088.26 be awarded to Fellmore Electrical Contractors Ltd.;
- 2. That a contingency allowance in the amount of \$50,000.00 be approved, within which the Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works is authorized to approve amendments to the Contract; and
- 3. That the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to sign the necessary documents.

<u>Purpose</u>

To obtain Council approval to award Contract T02-083.

Background - Analysis and Options

Contract T02-083 is for the supply and installation of traffic signals at the following intersections:

- 1. Woodbridge Avenue/Forest Drive;
- 2. Clark Avenue/Dufferin-Clark Community Centre access;
- 3. Creditstone Road/Langstaff Road;
- 4. Atkinson Avenue/Arnold Avenue;
- 5. Chrislea Road/Jevlan Drive;
- 6. Melville Avenue/Cunningham Drive; and
- 7. Applewood Crescent (north)/Millway Avenue.

The work is covered under Year 2002 Capital Budget Project 1443-0 in the amount of \$875,000.

The following bids were received:

1.	Fellmore Electrical Contractors Ltd.	\$ 503,088.26
2.	Stacey Electric Company Ltd.	\$ 520,365.72
3.	Guild Electric Ltd.	\$ 528,884.53
4.	Beacon Utility Contractors Ltd.	\$ 653,950.83

Fellmore Electrical Contractors Ltd. has the lowest bid, and has performed similar work for the City in the past and is considered capable of carrying out this contract.

Conclusion

It is recommended that Tender T02-083 in the amount of \$503,088.26 be awarded to Fellmore Electrical Contractors Ltd., that a contingency allowance for the contract in the amount of \$50,000.00 be approved, and that the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to sign the necessary documents.
