# NOISE BY-LAW EXEMPTION NORTH DON SEWER REHABILITATION REGION OF YORK

### Recommendation

A request was received from Conestoga-Rovers & Associates for an exemption to the Noise Bylaw for rehabilitation work on the North Don Sanitary Sewer System; between 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., Monday to Friday for three weeks within September and October. Re: North Dun Sewer Rehabilitation, Contract No. 83 Noise By-Law Exemption

Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA) is currently performing the design and construction services for the necessary rehabilitation of a section of the North Dun sanitary sewer system for the Region of York. In anticipation of the proposed construction activities, an exemption to Municipal By-Law 27081-2001 (Noise By-Law) will be required. The following points summarize the need for this exemption:

- Rehabilitation work on the sanitary sewer system must take place between the hours of 9:00 PM and 6:00 AM, Monday to Friday, to allow rehabilitation work of the sewer system during low flow periods.
- The existing sewer system is located on the Uplands Golf and Country Chib and the Thornbill Golf Chib. In order to minimize disruptions to golf course operations, the hours of work stipulated by the golf course owners is between the bours of 9:00 PM and 6:00 AM.

It is expected that this sever rebabilitation work will be undertaken within the months of.

September and October 2002. The rehabilitation work will require approximately 3 weeks for completion. The exact construction start date has not yet been determined and will be dependent on weather. In order to ensure that the necessary rehabilitation work is completed, we respectfully request that Council approve this exemption with the following provision:

This exemption covers work between 9:10 PM and 6:30 AM, Monday to Friday during the
month of September and the first two weeks of October 2002. All work shall take place
within the Region of York's easements as well as the Uplands Golf and Country Club and
the Thombill Golf Club properties. The exemption shall terminate upon completion of the
necessary rehabilitation work.

CRA will inform the City of Vaughan of the expected date of this work as soon as we confirm the successful contractor.
