NAPA VALLEY AVENUE AND AMARONE AVENUE ALLWAY STOP CONTROL

Recommendation

Councillor Linda Jackson recommends:

That an allway stop control be installed at the intersection of Napa Valley Avenue and Amarone Avenue.

Purpose

To review the feasibility of implementing an allway stop control at the intersection of Napa Valley Avenue and Amarone Avenue, in response to requests received from area residents.

Background - Analysis and Options

A petition was received from area residents who expressed concerns regarding the safety at the intersection of Napa Valley Avenue and Amarone Avenue. The residents have indicated that the grade on Napa Valley Avenue approaching reduces sight visibility.

Area residents have requested that an allway stop be installed.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that an allway stop control be installed at the intersection of Napa Valley Avenue and Amarone Avenue.

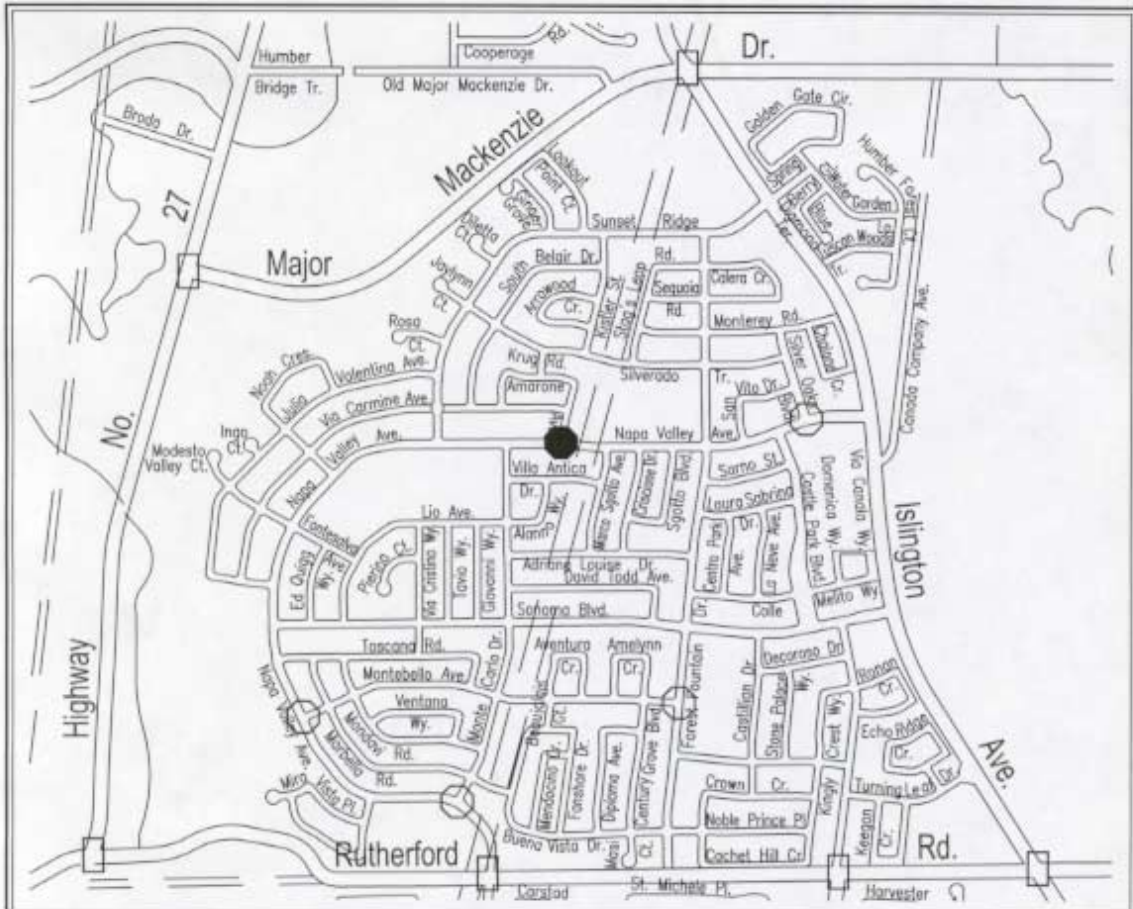
