CABINET CRESCENT PROPOSED 40 KM/HR SPEED LIMIT

Recommendation

Regional Councillor Gino Rosati recommends:

That the speed limit on Cabinet Crescent be reduced from 50 km/hr to 40 km/hr.

Purpose

To review the feasibility of implementing a 40 km/hr speed limit on Cabinet Crescent, in response to requests received from area residents.

Background - Analysis and Options

Area residents have expressed concerns regarding the excessive vehicle speeds and the safety of pedestrians on Cabinet Crescent. The existing speed limit on Cabinet Crescent is a statutory 50 km/hr.

Area residents have requested that the speed limit be reduced.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that the speed limit on Cabinet Crescent be reduced from 50 km/hr to 40 km/hr.

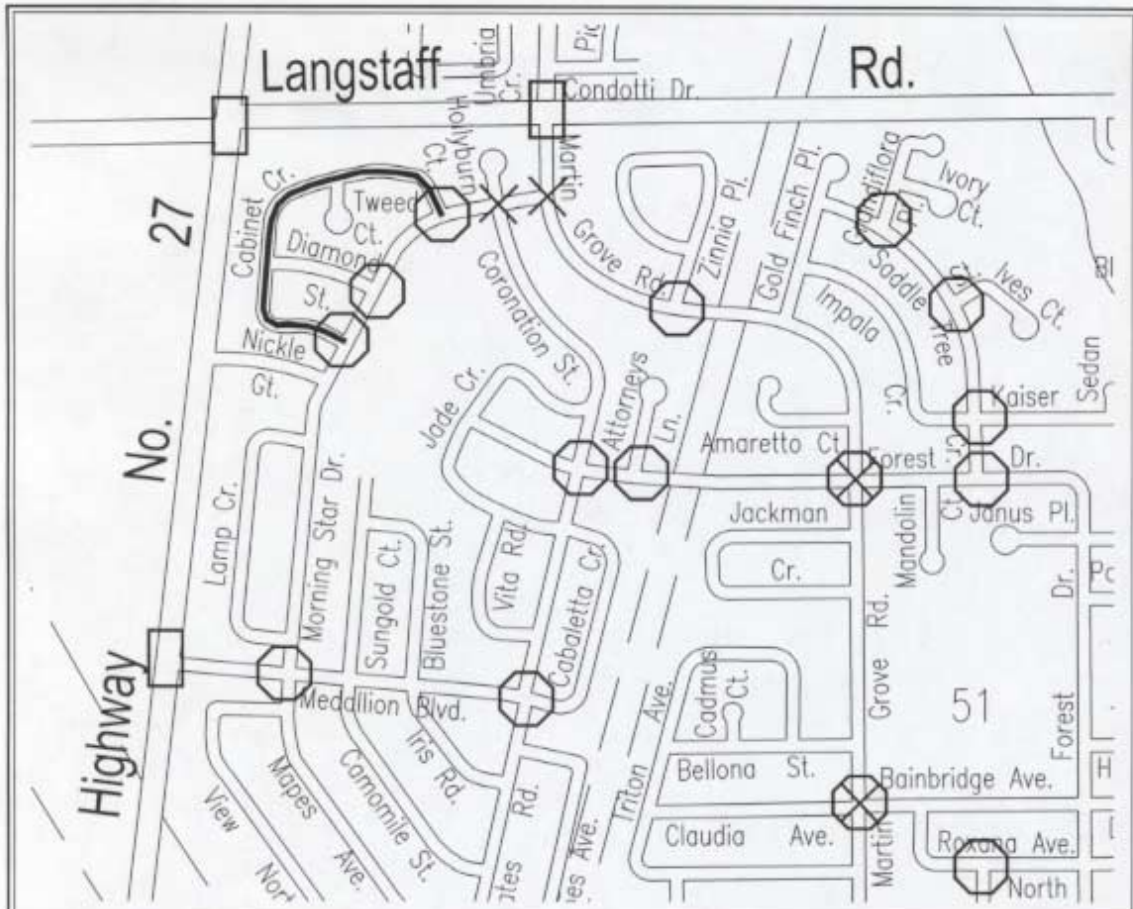
