

## **COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE – NOVEMBER 4, 2002**

### **AWARD OF TENDER T02-266 SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF VARIOUS PICKUP TRUCKS**

#### **Recommendation**

The Commissioner of Community Services, in consultation with the Executive Director of Buildings, Facilities and Parks, the Director of Purchasing, and the Director of Reserves and Investments recommends:

1. That Part "A" of Tender T02-266, for the supply and delivery of five (5) midsize 4x2 pickup trucks with extended cab, be awarded to Maclver Dodge Ltd. for a total price of \$127,040.50; and,
2. That Part "B" of Tender T02-266, for the supply and delivery of one (1) ½ ton full size 4x2 pickup truck with extended cab, be awarded to Northtown Ford Sales for a total cost of \$28,478.00; and,
3. That Part "C" of Tender T02-266, for the supply and delivery of one (1) ¾ ton heavy duty full size, 4x2 pickup truck with crew cab, be awarded to Northtown Ford Sales for a total cost of 34,128.55; and,
4. That Part "D" of Tender T02-266, for the supply and delivery of one (1) midsize 4x4 pickup truck with extended cab, be awarded to Maclver Dodge for a total cost of \$29,621.70.

#### **Purpose**

To award tender T02-266 for the supply and delivery of various pickup trucks.

#### **Background – Analysis and Options**

Council approved funds to purchase various pickup trucks as part of the ongoing equipment program. These projects were approved in 2002, as part of the capital budget and are funded from the Vehicle Reserve Fund, Development Charges and Taxation.

In part "A" the first four (4) low bidders did not meet the required specifications. The Ford and the GM compact size pickups they priced are not equivalent to the Dodge Dakota. They are smaller and do not meet the Gross Vehicle Weights as requested in the specifications.

This tender was advertised in the Liberal and the Electronic Tendering Network (ETN), with twenty two (22) bid documents issued and nine (9) received on closing date, October 2, 2002. The result of the bids including GST and PST are as follows:
