MARTIN GROVE ROAD PROPOSED PEDESTRIAN SIGNAL

Recommendation

Regional Councillor Gino Rosati recommends:

That a pedestrian signal be installed on Martin Grove Road near the Villa Giardino Senior Residence.

That an amount of \$50,000. be included in the 2003 Capital Budget for the design and construction of a pedestrian cross walk signalization.

Purpose

To provide a safe place for pedestrians, especially seniors to cross Martin Grove Road, in response to requests received from the residents.

Background - Analysis and Options

The residents of Villa Giardino have expressed concerns regarding the excessive vehicle speeds on Martin Grove Road and the safety of pedestrians to cross Martin Grove Road. There will be a transit stop and shelter implemented in the near future on the west side of Martin Grove Road. Many residents of Villa Giardino will need to cross the roadway to get to the transit stop.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from the residents of Villa Giardino, it is recommended that a pedestrian signal be installed on Martin Grove Road to provide a safe place to cross the roadway.

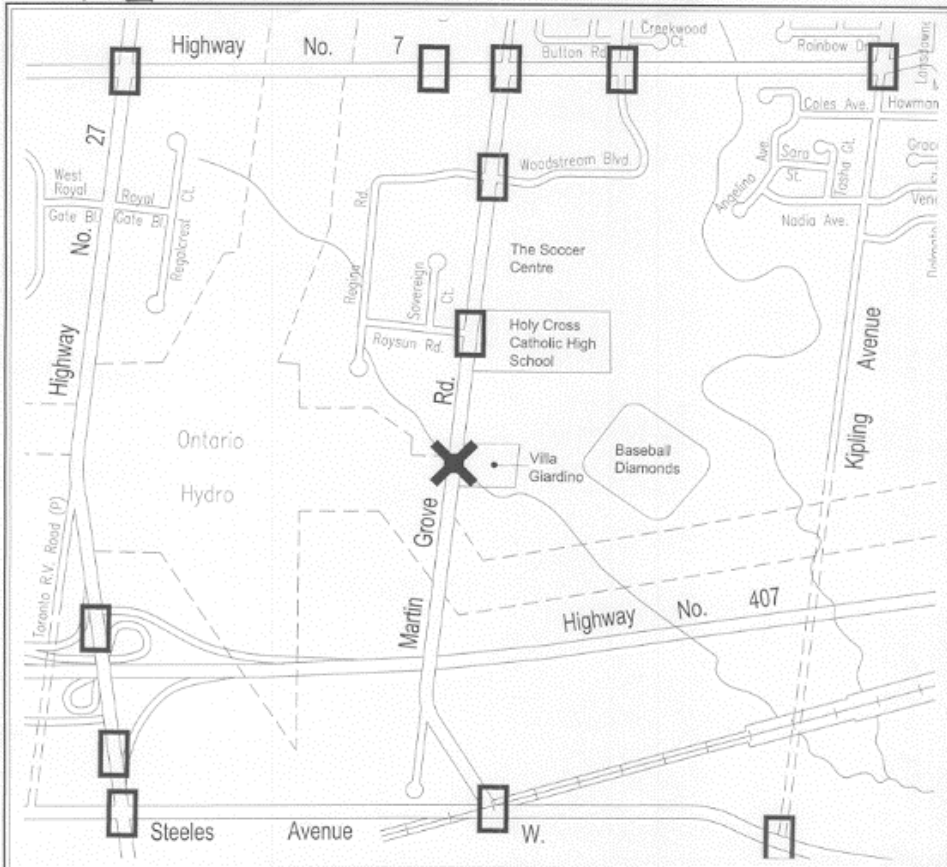
