VAUGHAN MILLS ROAD AND ROYALPARK WAY 3-WAY STOP CONTROL

Recommendation

Councillor Linda Jackson recommends:

That a 3-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Vaughan Mills Road and Royalpark Way.

Purpose

To review the feasibility of implementing a 3-way stop control at the intersection of Vaughan Mills Road and Royalpark Way, in response to requests received from area residents.

Background - Analysis and Options

Whereas, the Vaughan Mills bridge is now open to traffic, and

Whereas, area residents have expressed concerns about excessive speed and traffic infiltration along Vaughan Mills Road, and

Whereas, many motorists are using Vaughan Mills Road as a quick route between Langstaff Road, Kipling Avenue and Rutherford Road, and

Whereas, extension road work is occurring along Rutherford Road, and

A 3-way stop control at the intersection should be installed to curtail and slow down vehicular traffic.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that a 3-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Vaughan Mills Road and Royalpark Way.


