**CLARENCE STREET & TURNING LEAF DRIVE
3-WAY STOP CONTROL**

Recommendation

In response to requests from area residents, Regional Councillor Linda D. Jackson recommends that the following be referred to staff for a report:

To install a three-way stop control at the intersection of Clarence Street and Turning Leaf Drive.

Purpose

To reduce and control speeds along Clarence Street and to encourage motorists exiting Turning Leaf Drive to exercise caution when proceeding onto Clarence Street.

Background

Clarence Street is a busy road with motorists using it as a main access road into the Sonoma Heights subdivision.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that a three-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Clarence Street and Turning Leaf Drive.
