**NAPA VALLEY AVENUE AND SONOMA BOULEVARD  
3-WAY STOP CONTROL**

**Recommendation**

Councillor Linda Jackson recommends:

That a 3-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Napa Valley Avenue and Sonoma Boulevard.

**Purpose**

To review the feasibility of implementing a 3-way stop control at the intersection of Napa Valley Avenue and Sonoma Boulevard, in response to requests received from area residents.

**Background - Analysis and Options**

Whereas, previous traffic calming measures in this area have failed to reduce speeding to any significant degree, and

Whereas, excessive speeds continue to be a safety hazard to the area residents, and

A 3-way stop control at the intersection of Napa Valley Avenue and Sonoma Boulevard would slow traffic.

**Conclusion**

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that a 3-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Napa Valley Avenue and Sonoma Boulevard.
